

2019 Volunteer Opportunities & Events



Volunteers are our lifeblood.

There are many ways you can invest your time and energy into reaching abortion-vulnerable women in our community.

These positions require completion of our Volunteer Training Seminar (must be 21 or older to serve in these positions):

- **Dad Leaders:** Men needed to come alongside and coach new fathers as part of our 24/7 Dad™, Dr. Dad©, and Fatherhood Coach classes & outreach. *Time commitment may vary; occasional evening volunteer meetings required.*
- **Receptionist/ Client Advocate:** Answers the phone, helps welcome people; assists with routine office procedures. After reception training, trained in the center to meet with clients/patients individually; assesses needs, gives information. The commitment is 2 years minimum as the training in the center is extensive. *Time commitment is one 4-hour shift weekly; occasional evening volunteer meetings are required.*
- **Bella's Boutique Attendant:** Helps keep clothing room organized; assists moms & dads in selecting clothing & baby supplies; ministers to and prays with them as needed. *Time commitment is one 4-hour shift weekly; occasional evening volunteer meetings are required.*
- **Licensed, Certified Ultrasound Technician:** Administers ultrasounds to scheduled patients; works with Staff Nurses. *Time commitment may vary; occasional evening volunteer meetings are required.*
- **Registered Nurse:** Assists with ultrasound patients. Extensive ultrasound training possible if interested. *Time commitment may vary; occasional evening volunteer meetings are required.*
- **Abstinence Education Presenter:** Presents *No Regrets* program to school classes or youth groups- must be trained as receptionist first. The commitment is 2 years minimum as the training is extensive. *Time commitment may vary; one 4 hour shift in Center weekly, occasional evening volunteer meetings are required.*
- **Board Member:** Oversees the leadership of the ministry. This is a governance board. Board members do not work with clients and are not required to attend volunteer/staff meetings. The board meets monthly. Board potentials must take a portion of the training before serving on the board. ***This position is by invitation only.***

Spanish-speaking volunteers are needed!

These opportunities DO NOT require our Volunteer Training Seminar (no age restriction):

- **Building Maintenance Helper:** Light "handyman" activities as needed.
- **Church Link:** Works with home church to give Pregnancy Resources information out to congregation via bulletin inserts, brochures, posters, displays, and special announcements. Informs congregation of our volunteer training and fundraising events; recruits participants for the Pregnancy Resources Walk for Life; hosts a table at our annual spring banquet.
- **Cleaning Crew:** General cleaning of the centers. *This is a weekly time commitment; no meeting attendance required.*
- **Prayer Support Team:** Prays for the needs of the Centers; receives weekly email with current prayer requests.
- **Occasional "Helps":** Office projects, Special events, etc.

Volunteer Q & A

If I take the full volunteer training, am I automatically a center volunteer?

No. The training does not commit either you or Pregnancy Resources. If you take the training and decide you want to volunteer, you will submit a volunteer application and be interviewed by a Director to determine if there is a position for you here.

Should I take the training even if I'm not sure that I want to volunteer?

Yes! The training includes extensive information about abortion, effective communication skills, sharing the Gospel, and helping others in crisis. This info is useful to you in your local church and in your interpersonal relationships. It's a history and overview of this ministry. If you do volunteer, there is continued "in-house" training for specific positions.
